## Audition is Required

- Must be proficient on your instrument
- Will most likely take a music skills test that may consist of piano
- Will most likely take a basic music theory test
- An Interview may also be required
- Check Music Department/Studio for Audition Requirements
- Check audition schedules
- Some instruments and programs require a pre-screening video or audio recording

### Resume, Repertoire List, Essay

- Take every opportunity available (resume)
- Private Teacher, solo festival (Rep)
- Piano Lessons (Resume/skills)
- Theory Class (skills)
- Summer Programs (resume/teachers/skills)
- Eastman Community Music School, Hochstein, etc.
- Be thinking about the potential of your essay well in advance AND PROOFREAD! (you are now competing with students from around the world)

### College Visits

- Large Public or Private University
- Liberal Arts College
- Conservatory
- Trade Schools- AMDA or Full-Sail, etc.
- Don't look at money at this point- much opportunity for scholarship and financial aid available

# During your visit- early- maybe even Junior Year!

- Schedule a lesson with Primary Teacher
- Listen to a rehearsal
- Observe campus life
- ► Take time to visit with current students

#### Narrow your focus to 4-8 schools

- Diversify your choices
- Research teacher, program, etc.
- Look at options outside the field of music
- Are there secondary majors or minors
- Call the music department directly if you have questions regarding application process- can get very confusing

# **Audition Day Tips**

#### Students:

- Arrive early to everything
- Know expectations
  (audition, interview, test?)
- Dress professionally
- Don't compare yourself
- Eat good food
- Talk to current students!
- Take a tour of the school

- Get there the day before
- Expect to be there all day
- Expect your child to have to go off on their own
- Look for food places in advance
- Talk to current students!
- Don't expect the teacher to be available to talk on that day
