IHS JUNIOR AGREEMENT



The following conditions must be understood and agreed upon in order to attend the After Hours Party Friday, May 26, 2017 between 11:00 pm and 2:00 am:

1. All attendees (juniors and their prom guests) and their parents/ guardians are required to read and complete this agreement. **This party is for all IHS Juniors whether or not they attend the prom.** Guests are welcome ONLY if they attend the prom with an IHS Junior. A guest is anyone who is not a junior at IHS.
2. Only one prom guest per IHS Junior will be allowed.
3. All IHS Students must present their IHS ID at the door. If an IHS junior brings a non-IHS prom guest to the After Hours party, that guest must be registered by May 8, 2017.
4. The IHS Code of Conduct applies to all IHS Juniors and their prom guests. Violations of any school rule will be cause for dismissal from the event and a parent/guardian will be contacted for immediate pick-up.
5. Any IHS Junior or prom guest under the influence or in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs will be denied admission and their parent/guardian will be contacted. Use of alcohol or illegal drugs during the party will result in immediate dismissal, notification of and pick-up by parent/guardian.
6. The IHS Junior and their prom guest must arrive at the party by 12:30 am.
7. If an IHS Junior and their prom guest leave before 2:00 am, each person will be required to sign out. There is no re-admission to the party or loitering on school property.
8. To insure a safe environment, all backpacks will be subject to inspection. All backpacks will then be labeled and secured in a designated area for the duration of the student's stay at the After Hours Party. No weapons are allowed in the building.

The following conditions must be understood and agreed upon in order to attend the After Hours Party Friday, May 26, 2017 between 11:00 pm and 2:00 am:

1. All attendees (juniors and their prom guests) and their parents/ guardians are required to read and complete this agreement. This party is for all IHS Juniors whether or not they attend the prom.
