Scholarships

Detailed information is available in the College & Career Center. Unless otherwise noted, this information is for Seniors.

Leadership/Community Service/Academics/Athletics:

The Andrew G. Attinasi Scholar-Athlete Scholarship of \$3,000 is available to a graduating IHS senior who has participated on a sanctioned high school athletic team during each year of high school, has attended IHS for all four years of high school and plans to participate in intercollegiate athletics in college. **Deadline is May 7th.**

Big Sun Athletics is offering a \$500 scholarship to help young athletes succeed in their academic pursuits. All student athletes are eligible. Application information is available at www.bigsunathletics.com **Deadline: June 19th.**

Career Specific:

Each year the West Irondequoit Teachers' Association awards a \$1,500 scholarship, a \$1,000 scholarship, and a \$500 one-time award. The scholarship is a symbolic gesture of the pride the teachers at IHS have in the students they teach. These scholarships are awarded to a senior planning to enter a profession in Human Services including: Teaching, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Nursing, Psychology, Social Work, and Speech Pathology. **Deadline is: April 29th.**

The Frank Comisso Scholarship was established in 1997 in memory of Frank Comisso, a highly esteemed golf pro at Irondequoit Country Club. The number of awards may vary but are usually \$750 to \$1,000 each for academically talented, community-minded high school graduates with financial need. **Completed applications must be returned to Mrs. Bell by May 5th.**

Jennifer Grimes Linley Scholarship is awarding \$1,000 to a graduating high school female pursuing a degree in engineering or science at any 2 or 4 year college. You must demonstrate financial need and community involvement. **Deadline: May 5th.**

Ethnic:

Italian Civic League is offering two \$1,000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors who will be pursuing a college education immediately following graduation, residents of Monroe County and Americans of Italian lineage (at least one Italian grandparent). **Deadline: April 30th.**

Misc:

Abraham D. Chatman Scholarship will be awarding \$2,000 to a graduating high school senior who will be enrolling in a 2 or 4 year institution and is a dependent of a family member from a local union affiliated with Rochester Regional Joint Board, or Workers United. Applications available on-line at www.racf.org/Scholarships. **Deadline: May 1st.**

SAT deadline –May 9th for the June 6th test
Register online at www.collegeboard.com

The College Board has introduced important changes for registration for SAT testing for Test Security.

Admission Ticket Photo Guidelines:

- You are responsible for providing an acceptable photo when you register. To be acceptable, it must:
- Be clear, properly focused and correctly exposed
- Be taken in full-face view, directly facing the camera
- Match how you will look on the day of the test and in your photo ID
- School or government issued
- Original and valid (unexpired)
- In good condition and exactly matching the information you provided at registration.

You will be turned away if your photo does not meet the requirements.

These guidelines are just some of the points you need to know. Be sure to carefully review the complete list of photo and identification requirements given online at sat.org/test-day or in the Paper Registration Guide.
